



2010 SUMMER ASSESSMENT PAYMENT POLICY

Assessments Include

Instruction, rehearsal facilities, transportation to most parades, uniform, and season tour shirt for all members

Guard Members: Uniforms and extra required under garments, equipment including: flags and rifles.

Drumline Members: One SCAC white t-shirt and blue boxers for under uniforms, 1 bandana and percussion equipment including sticks and mallets

Band Proper: One SCAC white t-shirt and blue boxers for under uniforms, 1 pair of white gloves and 1 bandana

Honor Guard: One SCAC white t-shirt and blue boxers for under uniforms, 1 pair of white gloves, 1 bandana and honor guard equipment including flags, harnesses and side arms.

There will be optional fundraising opportunities for members to raise funds for their assessment fees.

Assessments Do Not Include

Spat Camp Food Donation: \$ 15 - covers 3 meals per day plus snacks

Shoes for all students: cost estimated to be between \$25.00 and \$35.00

Additional undergarments must be ordered and paid for before SPAT CAMP:

White SCAC t-shirt	\$ 5.00	SCAC Blue Boxers	\$ 12.00
Bandana	\$ 1.00	White Gloves	\$ 3.00

Black socks - required for Honor Guard, Band Proper and Drumline members.

Payments must be kept current. You must make a scheduled payment or have specific fundraising jobs scheduled to cover the amount due. All fundraising jobs must be communicated to the Assessment Secretary. If your fundraising opportunity is postponed or cancelled, you must make a personal payment to stay current. You will receive a refund if your account has a credit balance due to fundraised \$\$ after personal payments have been made. No fundraised \$\$ will be refunded - only personal payment \$\$.

We, the undersigned, understand that we are responsible for the full payment of the Summer 2010 Assessment through personal payment and/or fundraising efforts. We understand that all payments must be received by SCACMB on or before the above due dates in order to remain in good standing and to continue participation in the program.
