



Uniform Responsibility Policy

St. Cloud All City Marching Band's Uniform Responsibility Policy covers the care, maintenance, and member responsibility towards our uniforms. This policy's intent is to reduce the loss of property to the Band as well as teaching student responsibility in regards to caring for and wearing our uniforms. We also seek to instill pride in our members through the understanding of what our uniforms stand for as regards to membership in the All-City Organization.

In the past if your child showed up to parades/performances without proper pieces to their uniform they would have to sit out the performance. Unfortunately, this ends up affecting the entire band and the pride in our performance.

Uniform Part(s) Missing for Parade/Performance

If a student forgets a part(s) of their uniform, they will be charged \$10.00 on their assessment for each replacement provided by the band. There will be extra black socks, gauntlets, bandanas, gloves, T-shirts, and boxers stocked in the trailer. If an item is forgotten students must request replacements from lead chaperones. T-shirts, boxers, bandanas, socks and gloves are then bought and paid for with the \$10.00. Gauntlets, however, are part of the actual uniform and must be returned at the end of the performance.

Uniform Care and Cleaning

When uniforms are turned in at the end of the season we expect them to be returned in the same condition they were handed out; this includes proper cleaning, care and maintenance. Please refer to the St. Cloud All City web site for uniform care and washing instructions.
